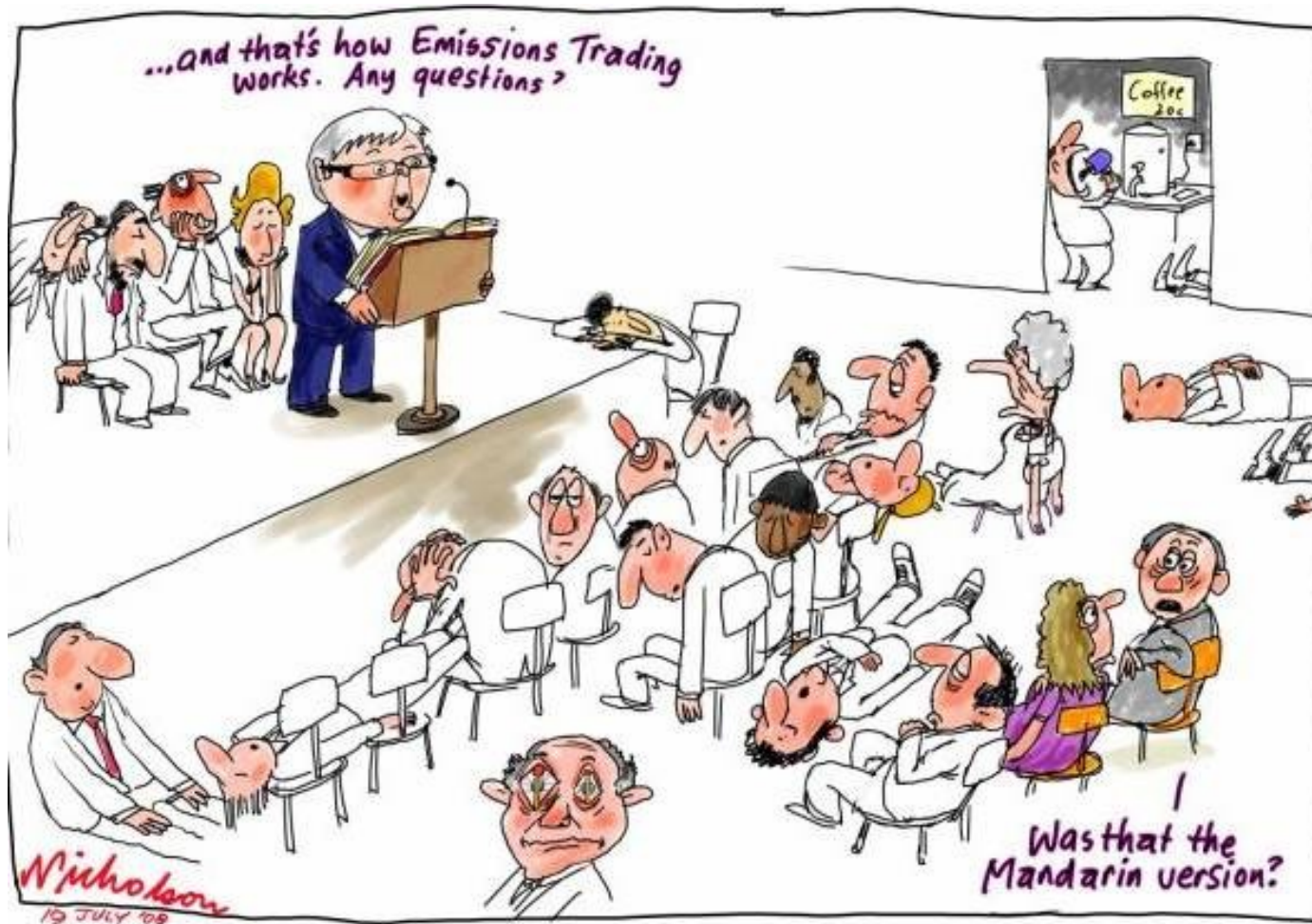




Why should I come to the Cairns

June 12th?



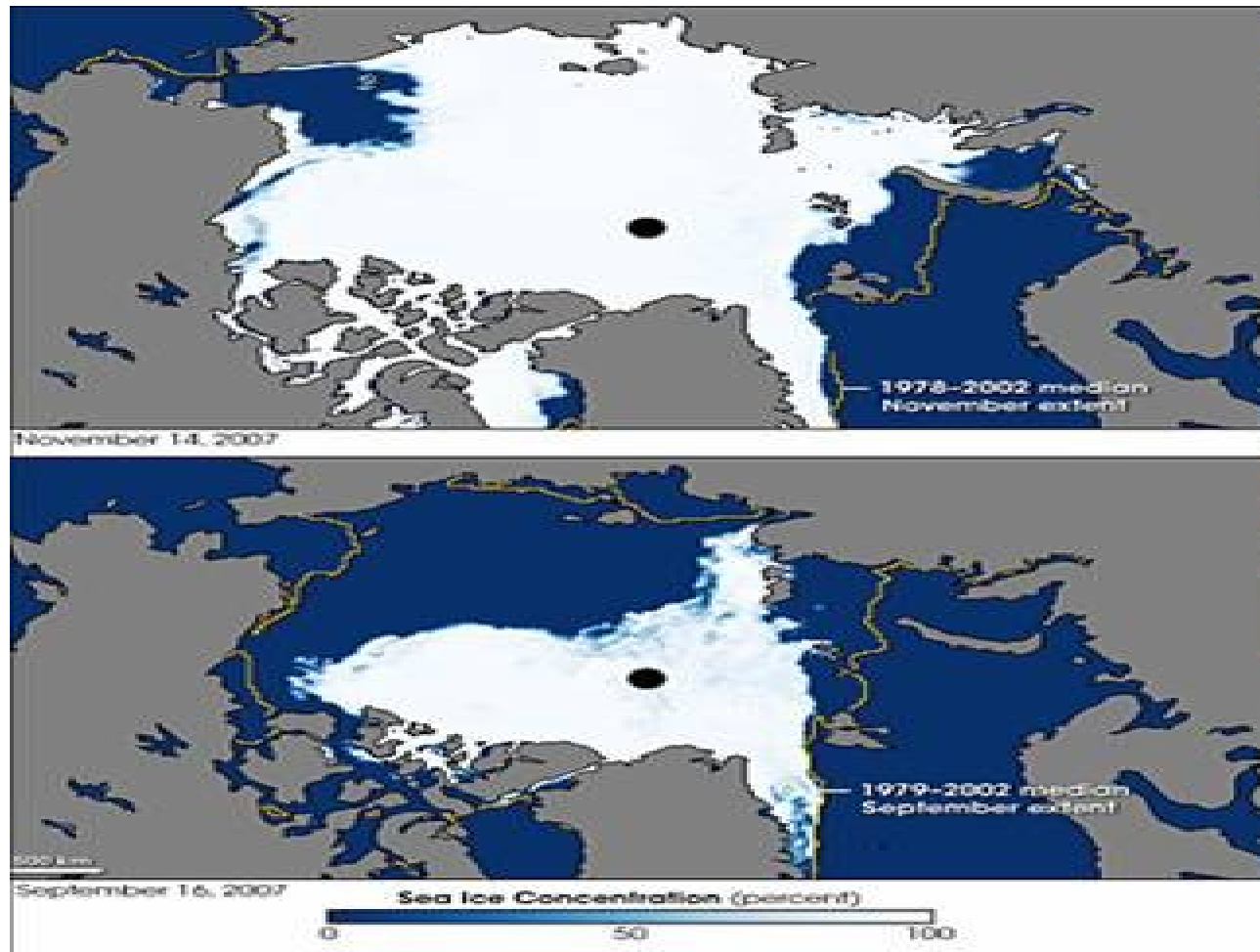
Action on climate change?delays and excuses....the proposed carbon reduction scheme compensates big polluters!

We must beat the coal and other fossil fuel lobby groups, who have held Canberra captive for so long.



The Earth needs ***serious help*** – not 5% token carbon reductions.

Already the Arctic is melting from too much carbon in the air – we must not only slow the growth of CO₂ in the atmosphere – we have to actually ***reduce*** it.



This means committing ourselves to *significant carbon reductions* – there is no other way. Humans cannot negotiate with the climate.



Al Gore has called for *100% renewable energy by 2020* as the only way to avoid climate catastrophe.



In the 1960s, the US committed itself to putting a human on the moon by the end of the decade. A huge percentage of the national economy was channeled towards this end, and they achieved the “impossible”.
