The emPower Fest 2007 to be held at the Tanks Art's Centre, Edge Hill from 7th to 12th July 2007; invites you to have your say.

Last year our emPower team hosted the successful emPower Energy Fest 2006 at the Kuranda Amphitheatre with local scientists, Aboriginal elders and world-renown environmentalist Dr. David Suzuki.

Building on that success, this year we are presenting a six day Global Warming and Peak Oil exhibition including several events to coincide with the "Live Earth" concerts.

Our local Community Action Day will include the following competitions:

- Primary School Students a 2-3 minute Speech to a Government Body on what you want our Local, State or Federal government to do about global warming and/or a sustainable future. The three finalists will be asked to read their speeches at the event.
- Secondary School Students an essay of 400 to 800 words which can include up to three illustrations titled "My Visions of a Sustainable Future".
- For all students create a visual art piece (preferably 2D of either A3 or A2 size) with a short description (up to 100 words) titled "My Visions of a Sustainable Future".
- For all students write and perform a song about global warming and/or your vision of a sustainable future. Entrants need to be available to perform their song on 7th or 8th July. Entries supplying the text of the song or a CD are preferred.

Entry forms must be **registered by 1st June**. All speeches, essays, art pieces or songs need to be received by emPower by **Thursday 21**st **June 2007** (see below for addresses).

Any entries received after the specified date will not be accepted.

Final judging will be held at the Tanks Art's Centre during emPower Fest 2007. Prizes will be given for the most original works, with the winner of each category being presented with a bonus prize for their school.
